Alexander Garnet Johnson, 95, of Nedrow, New York, died Tuesday, October 12, 2010 at Iroquois Nursing Home. Alex was born in Ottawa Canada on July 27, 1915. He owned and operated the Westend Bike Shop and Westboro Bike Shop. Alex served in the Royal Canadian Air Force during the Second World War where he was stationed in Arnprior Ontario Canada and Prince Edward Island. After the war, Alex and his wife Marjory operated a small berry farm where they grew strawberries and raspberries as cash crops. In the off-season, he worked at Fraser Duntile, The Royal Bank and a printing shop. He and his wife eventually owned and operated a Laundromat, The Washateria. In 1956 he moved his family to Syracuse, New York where he owned the Alma Motel in Mattydale, New York. After a few years, he bought and operated the Al-Bel Motel on South Salina in Nedrow, New York. He was predeceased by his son, James G. Johnson, who passed away on April 15, 1996. He is survived by his wife of 68 years, Marjory (Graham) Johnson; a daughter and son-in-law, Bonita and James Davis; a sister, Edith King of Ottawa Canada; grandsons, James, Jeffrey and Jonathon Johnson; granddaughter, Melanie Davis of Cocoa Beach, Florida; three great-grandchildren, Nina, Mae and Tyler; many nieces and nephews. 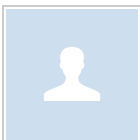

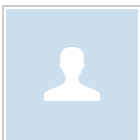
