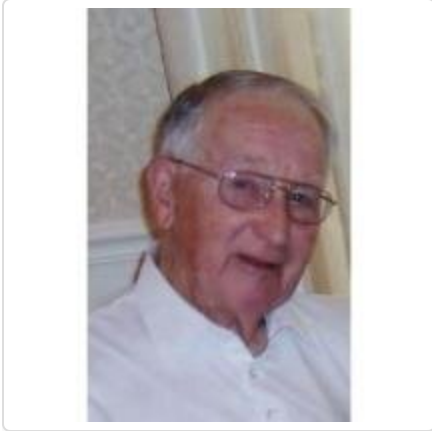




Alton E. Arnold

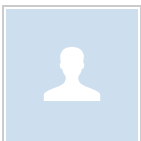
