Anne G. Chilton, 83, died Saturday, March 5, 2005 at Van Duyn Home & Hospital, Onondaga Hill, New York.

Anne was born July 11, 1921 in Chaumont Bay, the daughter of Charlie Harold and Pauline (Jackson) Needo. She graduated from Girls Cathedral in New York City and attended Syracuse University.
