Anthony T. "Jack" DiNuzzo, 87, of Syracuse, New York died Friday, July 30, 2004 at St. Camillus Health & Rehabilitation Centre, Syracuse.

Anthony was born June 25, 1917 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Frank and Antoinetta (Razano) DiNuzzo. He retired as a carpenter from Syracuse University in 1982 after 23 years and was a member of Service Employees International Union. 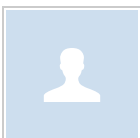

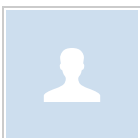
