Arlene J. Hanlin, 101, of Syracuse, New York died Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at St. Camillus Health and Rehabilitation Center. The daughter of the late William and Rose Conrad Eddy, she was a life resident of the Syracuse area.

She was a graduate of CCBI and retired from Syracuse University where she worked as a Library Clerk. Arlene was a communicant of St. James Church.
