A native of the Onondaga Nation he was the son of the late Edward and Ida Bennett Jones. He retired from Local 60 Laborers Union in 1995 following many years of service. He was a US Army veteran serving in the Korean Conflict. Art was a member of the Oneida Nation and its Turtle Clan. Mr. Jones was member of the USA National LaCrosse Hall of Fame, a founding member of the Onondaga Nation Little League and an avid sports fan especially the NY Yankees. He was an active member of the American Legion Valley Post 1468. He was predeceased by two sons, Kirk D. in 2009 and Arthur W. "Tubby" Jones, Jr. in 1994. Surviving are his wife of 63 years, the former Lenora Confer; three sons, Vern (Shirley) Jones of Marietta, New York, Jamie (Karen) Jones of Jamesville, New York and David Steeprock of Syracuse, New York; a daughter, Wanda (Patrick) Rommevaux of DeRuyter, New York; a sister, Irene Greene of Oneida, New York; 11 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
