Barnard L. Allen, age 84, of Camillus, New York died Wednesday, September 11, 2002 at home.

Mr. Allen was born March 27, 1918 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Frank B. and Kathryn (Wilcox) Allen. He was a self-employed attorney for Barnard L. Allen Attorney at Law from 1973 to the present.
