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Baron W. Duncan, 48, passed away Monday, July 16, 2012 after a five year battle with cancer. He was surrounded by his wife and close friends.

Baron played bass guitar since he was 4 years old. Though a well known local musician, he also toured nationally for 10 years, headlining the motorcycle rally in Sturgis, South Dakota being one of his most notable accomplishments.

When baron wasn't on stage, he was in the kitchen either at home, or in one of the many restaurants he worked at in the Syracuse Area. Baron graduated from Jamesville-DeWitt High School and studied music at Onondaga Community College.

He is survived by his new bride, Kim; his lovely 12 year old daughter, Jenna who resides in Nebraska and a sister, Gweneviera (Alan) from Texas. Baron's dad, Baron Sr. passed away in 2008 and his mom, Gweneviera just passed away last June.

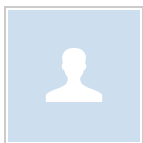

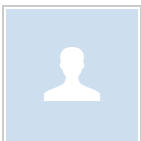
