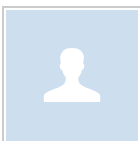

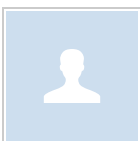

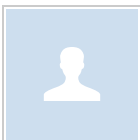
“ *We enjoyed getting together with David and Carole over the years. They were alot of fun to be with. We will miss Carole very much. We are so sorry for your loss.*
