



Caroline Sager Irving

May 18, 1936 - April 28, 2016

Caroline Sager Irving, 79, died Wednesday, April 28, 2016, after battles with Post-Polio and Cancer. She was predeceased by her loving husband, Edward Irving, in 1990 and her brothers, Harry Sager in 1986 and Henry Sager in 2015.

Caroline graduated from Onondaga Valley Academy as class valedictorian and from Central City Business Institute. She was a member of DeWitt Community Church, where she worked for 36 years and was the Church Business Administrator. She previously worked for Security Mutual Life Insurance Co., the US Air Force Contract Office and the Federal Housing Administration as a Loan Servicing Representative. Caroline enjoyed sewing, refinishing furniture, gardening and scrapbooking.

Caroline is survived by her son Ken (Amy) Irving of LaFayette, New York; daughter, Joanne (John) Ranz of Brewerton, New York; brothers, Carl (Dorothy) of Altamont, New York and John (Sandy) Sager of Marcellus, New York; and sisters-in-law Bernie Sager of Texas and Andy Cottet of Cleveland, New York. Also surviving are grandchildren, Kolby, of Dublin, Ohio, and Jacob Irving of LaFayette, New York, Matthew (Jennifer) of New Hampshire and Andrew (Heather) Ranz of Connecticut; four great-grandchildren, several nieces and nephews.

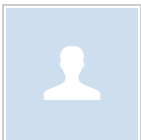
