Charles Noon Getson, 91, of "The Valley", in Syracuse, New York, passed away Saturday, March 29, 2008 in Florida. Charles was born May 23, 1916 in Brookfield, New York, the son of John and Monica (Klinkna) Getchonis. He retired from Accurate Die Casting Company as a Tool & Die Maker after 44 years of service. Noon was a member of the American Bell Association for 43 years and a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church.
