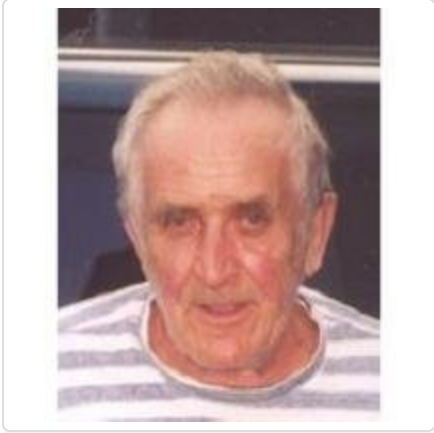




Charles Wychules
