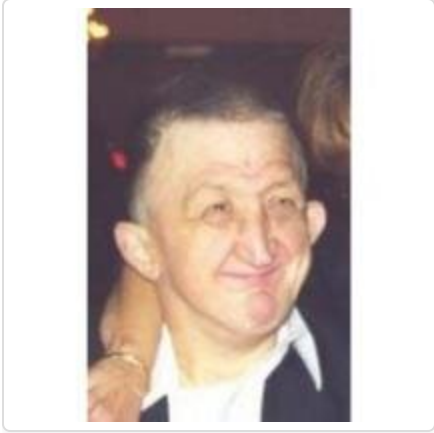




Concetto DiMauro

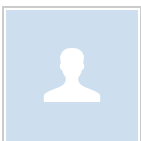

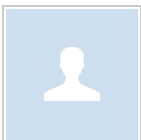

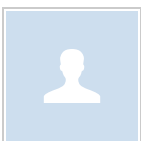
“ *With all our love rest in peace. We know you are in a better place and know we will meet again.*

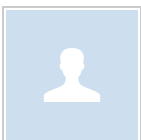
