Daniel J. Murphy Jr., age 80, of Taunton, New York died Monday, March 22, 2004 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center, Syracuse, New York.

Daniel was born September 13, 1923 in Little Falls, New York, the son of Daniel J. and Edna (Snell) Murphy. He was employed by and a life member of the Bricklayers Union Local 28, Syracuse, New York, retiring in 1975. He was a Navy veteran of World War II, serving in the Atlantic and Pacific Theaters. 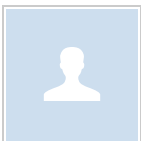
