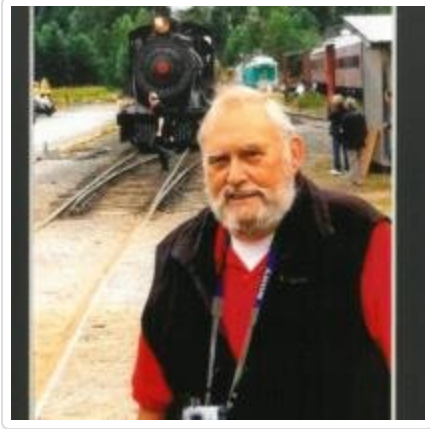




Donald James Richman
