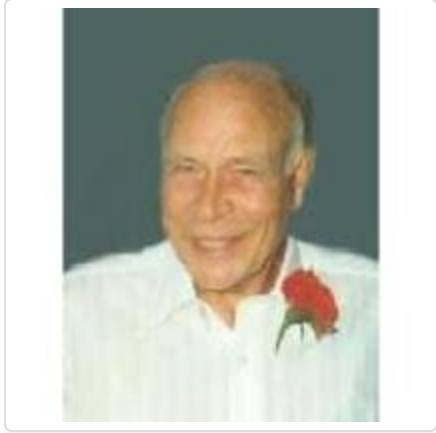




Donald S. Waters

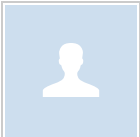
