Dorothy E. Baldwin, 92, of The Valley, in Syracuse, NY, died Monday, December 21, 2015 at the home of her daughter and son-in-law. She was a graduate of Syracuse Memorial Hospital, Class of 1945 and was employed as a registered nurse, working at Syracuse Memorial Hospital and later, in a local medical practice, retiring in 1981 after 45 years of service.

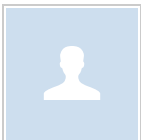
