Eben Blake Page III, (a/k/a E. P. Blakey), 89, of Baldwinsville, NY and Jamesville, NY died Thursday, October 2, 2014 at Loretto. Born in Winchester, MA, he attended Manlius Military School. He operated a Ford dealership in Scituate, MA until he moved to the Syracuse, NY area in 1960. He was president of Blakey Trucking, Inc. and V.P. of Basic Industries, Inc., and later was owner of Sentinel Press. He was a charter member of the LaFayette Optimist Club and a past Lieut. Governor. A Democrat in politics, and involved with Union affairs, he was known as an artist, entertainer and genealogist, tracing his ancestry 46 generations to include Alfred the Great, Charlemagne and the royal families of Sweden, Norway, Scotland, England, France and Portugal, and was descended from thirteen "Mayflower" families. Mr. Page is survived by his sons, Gregory (Betty) Page and Ben (Laurie) Page; daughters, Esther Klaiber, Olive (Elliott) Fleury and Linda (Bill) Myers; sister, Ann Freeman; 13 grandchildren and numerous great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by his first wife, Georgianne (Barnes); his second wife, Ella (Crowell) Miner-Page; son-in-law, Alfred Klaiber and a brother, Gordon Page.
