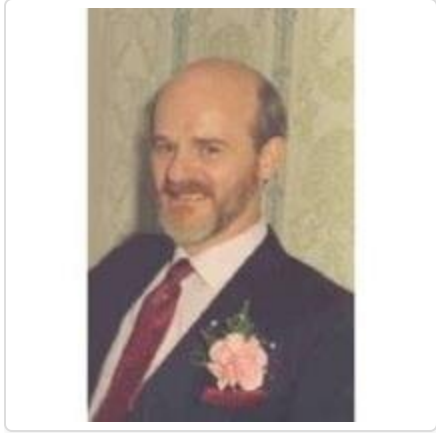




Edward F. Burton
