Edward E. "Gumpy" Stanton, 81, of Jamesville, NY, died Friday, January 8, 2016 at the VA Hospital. He was the owner of Stonefield Cleaning & Janitorial and following retirement, he served as assistant office manager for the family business, Commercial Painting. Ed was an US Army veteran serving during the Korean Conflict and an US Air Force veteran serving during Vietnam. He was a member and Deacon of the former Elmwood Presbyterian Church, a member of American Legion Valley Post 1468 and Southside Businessmen's Association. He loved playing cards, casino trips, gardening and family. He was a proud former member of the OCS School Board

Ed is survived by his sons, David (Theresa) Stanton and James (Melissa Allen) Stanton; daughters, Tammi Rahrle and Heather (Jeddie Jr.) Stanton-Pitre; sisters, Norma Morey and Marie Egloff; 13 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his former wife and friend, Suzanne Stanton who died November 25, 2015 and son-in-law, Brian Scott Rahrle who died August 8, 2009.

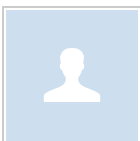

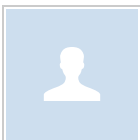

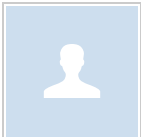
