Elizabeth "Betty" Ryan-Beach, 81, of Clay, New York died Wednesday, January 21, 2004 at St. Joseph's Hospital, Syracuse, New York.

Elizabeth was born May 6, 1922 in Cadyville, New York, the daughter of Elmer and Julia (Bassett) Ryan. She was formerly the manager of The Cecile Center in the Valley, Syracuse, New York. She was a communicant of Christ the King Roman Catholic Church, a member of American Legion Post 1468 Auxiliary and North Syracuse VFW Auxiliary. She was a very active volunteer with the American Cancer Society in Clay.
