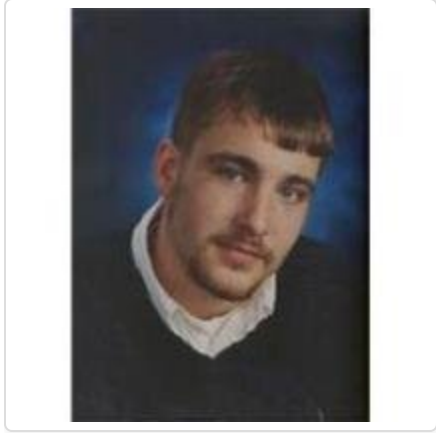




Eric J. Mulhauser
