She was an avid sports fan partial to the New York Yankees and professional wrestling. She was preceded in death by her husband, Peter Goulet, four sons and 11 siblings. She was the beloved grandmother of Karen, Ray and Barry Halbritter, in addition to 11 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.
