Floyd S. Woodworth, age 87, of 101 Ferndale Drive, Syracuse, New York died Monday, June 16, 2003 at Iroquois Nursing Home, Jamesville, New York.

Floyd was born April 29, 1916 in Fayetteville, New York the son of Floyd S. and Marie Woodworth. He was born and raised on the family farm on Woodchuck Hill Road and Snooks Pond.
