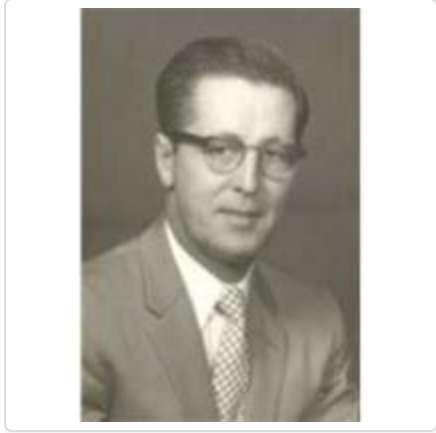




Frederick W. Crabtree

Frederick W. Crabtree, 82, of Nedrow, New York died Monday, July 5, 2004 at home.
