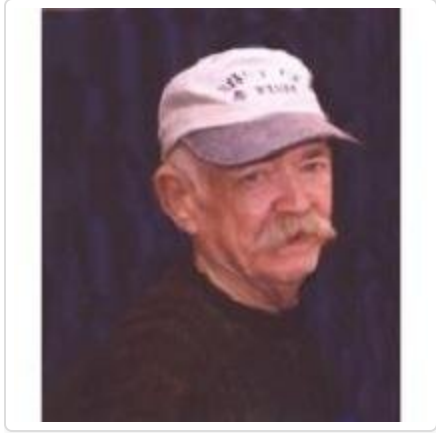




Fredrick George Passett

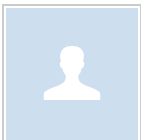

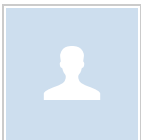

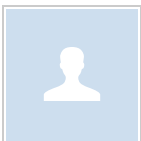
