Genevieve M. "Gen" Doud, age 90, of Syracuse, New York died Saturday, November 9, 2002 at Community General Hospital, Onondaga Hill, New York.

Genevieve was born June 5, 1912 in Waverly, New York, the daughter of Daniel J. and Margaret (Murphy) Limerick. She was the wife of Lucien H. Doud who died in 1956. She received her undergraduate degree from Mansfield State Teachers College, Mansfield, Pennsylvania Class of 1934 and she did her graduate work at Syracuse University receiving a Masters in Special Education.
