Trudy Hathaway, 55, of "The Valley" in Syracuse, New York died Wednesday, January 26, 2005 at home.

Trudy was born August 21, 1949 in Syracuse, New York, the daughter of Raymond William and Alice May (Lagoe) Wunder. She received her Bachelor Degree from Houghton College and her Master of Science from Cortland State. 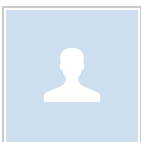
