



Glenn H. Bishop, Jr.

May 6, 1929 - November 1, 2014

Glenn H. Bishop Jr., 85, was born in the town of Otisco. He is the son of Glenn H. and Anna Kamm Bishop. Glenn was an Army Veteran serving as mortar Sgt. in the 7th Army in Germany. He was a member of Teamsters Local 317 and was employed as a road driver for Schuster's Express for 34 years and also served as union steward. Glenn helped form the Teamsters Federal Credit Union and served on the board of directors for two terms. He also was a charter member of the Vesper Fire Dept., later becoming part of Tully Hose Co., serving as Assistant Chief. He was a member of American Legion Post 936 where he served as Commander for two terms, a member of the Lake Worth, Florida VFW, and a member of Homer Elks Lodge No. 2506. He also belonged to the American Truck Historical Society. After his retirement from the Teamsters, he joined his son, John, building many custom homes and business buildings in Onondaga and Cortland Counties. Glenn moved to West Palm Beach, Florida, in 1992 and returned to the Tully area in 2006. Glenn is survived by his wife, Sharon (Van Patten) Bishop; three sons, John D. (Dawn) Bishop, Jerry W. Bishop, and Craig (Christine) Clemons; three daughters, Jacquelyn K. (Wade) Santerre, Jill M. (Dewey) Northrup, and Julie A. Bishop; one step-son, Dirk (Deedee) Van Patten; two step-daughters, Cindy (Brian) Young, and Andrea (Wayne) Drake; 17 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews. Glenn was predeceased by his parents, Glenn and Anna Bishop; his first wife, Barbara (Baker) Bishop; four sisters, Eloise Bailey, Helen Hubbel, Camilla Kehrer, and Maxine Berry. Calling hours

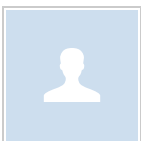
