She had been a resident of the Bernardine Apartments for the past four years. A longtime resident of LaFayette, New York, she was predeceased by her husband, J. Burge Morris (1992), a daughter, Priscilla M. Robinson (1998), her sister Eva M. Reynolds (2002) and her brother James E. McVoy (2005). She is survived by her son, Douglas (Judy) of LaFayette, New York and daughter, Elizabeth (Karl) Esmark of Vesper, New York. She was a member of the LaFayette Columbian Presbyterian Church for 81 years and served in numerous capacities, including superintendent of the Sunday school and as an elder. 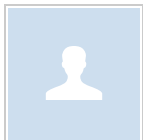
