Howard was employed by the former Pelnik Wrecking Company. He was a Marine Corps veteran of the Korean War. He was a member of American Legion Valley Post 1468, DAV and a former Chief of the Onondaga Nation Fire Department. Howard enjoyed camping, boating, gardening, canning tomatoes and making pickles and is often referred to as the 'pickle man' amongst his neighbors on Onondaga.
