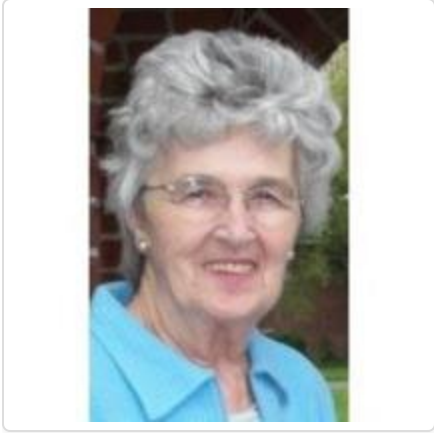




Jane L. Valentino

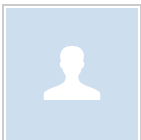

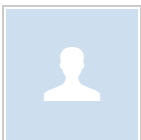
