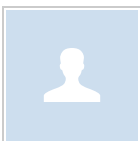

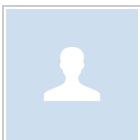


“ *Dear family,*

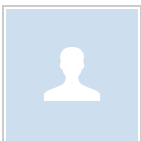

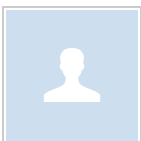
