John M. "Jack" Loudon of Syracuse died suddenly on Monday, August 10, 2015 at home. Born on June 19, 1921 in Cheyenne, WY, he was raised in Denver, CO where he graduated from the University of Denver. Upon graduation he relocated to Schenectady, NY joining General Electric as a Professional Engineer. While there he met and married Jane Zmyslowski. After 68 years of marriage she preceded him in death in August of 2014. In 1946 he was transferred to the Syracuse plant where he worked until his retirement in HMED for 42 years. He had become well known throughout the industry for his work in Metric Standardization.

Settling in The Valley, he was an active participant as a member of St. Andrews Episcopal Church serving the Vestry, the youth group and the couples club. An avid bowler, he was also a member of the Westvale golf leagues and enjoyed playing in tournaments. He was a member of the Konosioni Masonic Lodge 950 and was recently honored by the order for a membership of over 50 years. For over 20 years he wintered in Tucson, AZ where he was active at Grace Episcopal Church volunteering with the men's group and making longtime friendships with other snow birds.

Jack is survived by his two children, Janet (Bradford J.) Ward of West Hartford, CT and Judi Derriso of Warner Robins, GA; three grandchildren, Stacy Ward and her husband, Michael McCarthy of Ames, NY, Katie (Ben)

Bare of Wethersfield, CT and Matt (Rosannah) Waterman of Atlanta, GA and two great-grandchildren, Benji and Tessa. He leaves a nephew and nieces and their families. He was predeceased by his sister.

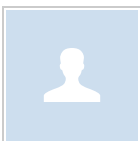
