John Daniel "Dan" Milicich, age 62, of Marietta, New York died Wednesday, October 30, 2002 at Crouse Hospital, Syracuse, New York.

John was born December 6, 1939 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Stephen and Pauline (Patell) Milicich. He graduated from Onondaga Valley Academy. He was employed by Dunk & Bright Furniture Company as a Supervisor of the Display Department for 36 years and he retired in 1998 after 26 years as Captain for the Syracuse Fire Department. He was the Fire Commissioner for Otisco and Amber Volunteer Fire Departments. He was the recipient of the Local 280 Valor Award in July 1993, the EMS Certificate of Merit in July 1996, the Jenkins Medal in August 1996 and the 2001 Fire Fighter of the year from Amber Volunteer Fire Department.
