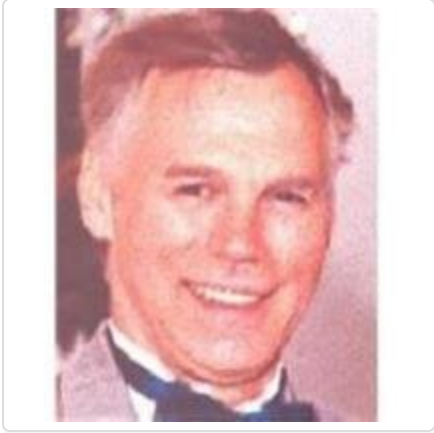




John P. Tenhave

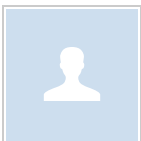
