Julia Ann Daniels, lovingly known as "Frama" by her grandchildren, age 66, of North Syracuse, New York died Saturday, September 9, 2006 at home.

Julia was born August 17, 1940 in Hogansburg, New York, the daughter of Amos and Rose (Tarbell) DeGonzague. She was a well known and respected antique dealer owning and operating The Antique Loft in North Syracuse for 25 years.
