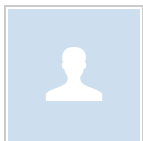

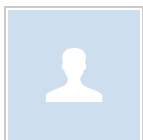
“ *My deepest sympathy to Lenny and his brother and sisters. It has been a while but have thought of you guys often. God bless you guys. My heart is with you.*
