Leonard E. White, 88, of Shallotte, North Carolina, and formerly of Patterson Road, Marietta, New York, died Saturday, May 6, 2006 at home.

Leonard was born in South Onondaga on May 23, 1917, the son of Elton "Mitch" White and Hilda Block. He was a very active member of Otisco Union Church and Old Shallotte Baptist Church. Leonard retired in 1979 from Stauffer Chemical Company after 25 years of service. An Army veteran of WWII, he was a member of the American Legion in Shallotte.
