Lester Gordon Jarvis, 82, of Jamesville, New York, died Wednesday, December 13, 2006 at home.

Lester was born March 25, 1924 in Tupper Lake, New York, the son of Edward and Gertrude (Gaff) Jarvis. He retired as a patrolman with Allied Chemical and as a Special Deputy with the Onondaga County Sheriffs Department. He was an Army Veteran of World War II and a member of VFW Post 3120.
