Lewis C. Auburn, age 86, of Syracuse, New York died Tuesday, February 5, 2002 at Van Duyn Home & Hospital, Onondaga Hill, New York.

Mr. Auburn was born June 17, 1915 in Fairport, New York, the son of Arthur and Clara (Sinamus) Auburn. He lived in Rochester, New York most of his life.
