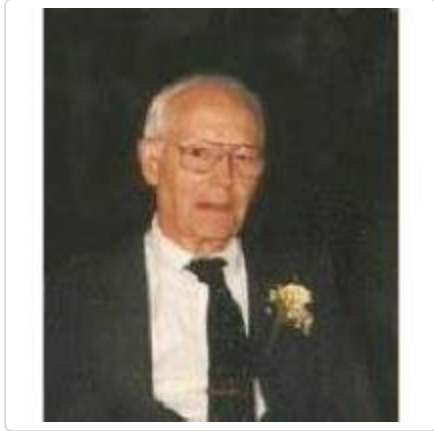




Lewis K. Rienhardt

July 31, 1914 - September 10, 2002

Lewis Knapp Rienhardt, age 88, formerly of W. Seneca Turnpike, Onondaga Hill, New York died Tuesday, September 10, 2002 at Seneca Hill Manor, Oswego, New York.

Lewis was born July 31, 1914 in Syracuse, New York, the son of John E. and Lila (Knapp) Rienhardt. He attended Onondaga Valley Academy. He worked on the family farm, Valley Dairy. He later worked as a clam operator for New York Central Railroad and as a security officer for Community General Hospital.
