Madalyn B. Lancette, 78, of the Onondaga Nation, died Wednesday, December 17, 2014 at Upstate University Hospital. She was employed by MCOA as a Neighborhood Advisor for 30 years and she worked for native american elders for 40 years. Madalyn was a member of the Beaver Clan of the Onondaga Nation, North American Indian Club and WIBC where she was on the Board of Directors for 40 years. She received an award for 25 years of service for Neighborhood Advisor. Madalyn is survived by her sons, James (Sharon) and Mark (Colleen) Lancette; daughter Yvonne Lancette-Karschner; brothers, Jerome (Paulette) and William Lazore; sisters, Cecelia LaDuke and Loretta (James) Devereaux; sister-in-law, Sandra Lazore; eight grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her parents, William and Rachel (Farmer) Lazore and brother, Philip Lazore. Funeral services will be held Saturday, December 20, 2014, 8:30 a.m. at Ballweg & Lunsford Funeral Home, LaFayette, NY 13084. Burial will be in Onondaga Valley Cemetery. 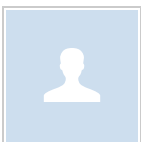

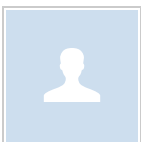
