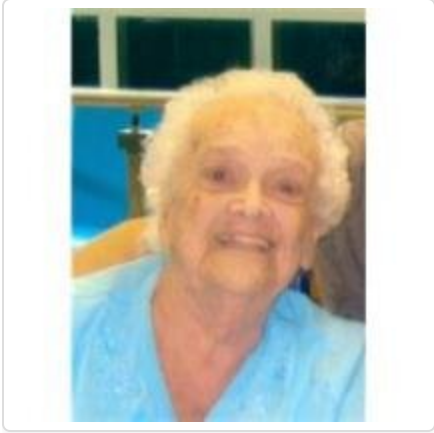




Marjorie Marion Vollmer
