Mark Augustus Warren, 67, of Fabius, NY, left this life to be with his Lord Jesus on September 11, 2017, after a long struggle with cancer. Born in Batavia, NY, he was son of Gus and Laura (Pratt) Warren. Mark was a Vietnam Veteran, having served in the US Navy from 1969-1973, and a Reservist until 2005. He married the love of his life, the former Annette Pigula, in 1979, and was retired from his job as pattern and model maker at Copesetic, Inc. in Morrisville, NY.

Mark's hobbies included flying remote control model airplanes, camping, and most recently, bicycling. He was an excellent handyman and a faithful member of his church. Mark was a kind, gentle encourager to all he met and a good friend and husband.

In addition to Annette, his wife of 38 years, Mark is survived by his mother, Laura Warren; brothers, Gary (Dana) Warren and David (Kelly) Warren; sisters, Kathie (Richard) Holzschuh and Wendy (Ben) Ritzenthaler; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father.

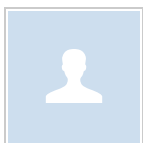

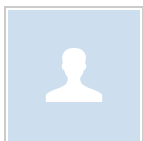
