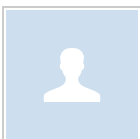

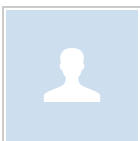

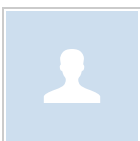
“ *Miss you more than ever.*

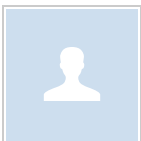
