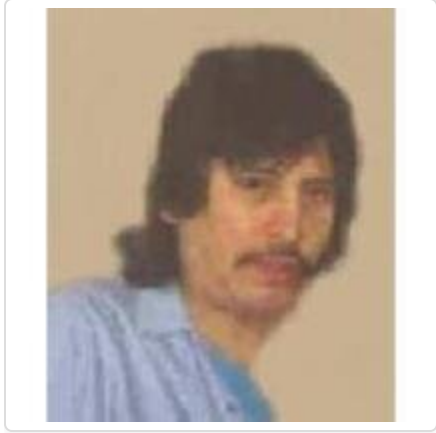




Melvin A. Mel" Doctor

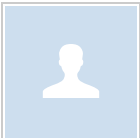

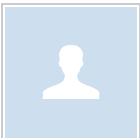

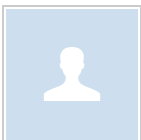
