February 5, 1903 - April 11, 2004

Mildred Buck Rickley, 101, died Easter Sunday, April 11, 2004 at Van Duyn Home & Hospital, Onondaga Hill, New York.

Mildred was born February 5, 1903 on Onondaga Hill, the daughter of Fred and Laura (Abbey) Buck. She was a graduate of Onondaga Valley Academy and graduated Cum Laude from Syracuse University in 1924. During her career, she taught science, Latin, was vice-principal at Raquette Lake Union School and retired in 1964 after 23 years teaching mathematics at Moravia Central High School.
