She was a member of the Snipe Clan, a Clan Mother and an active committee member for American Indian Community House in Syracuse.

She was predeceased by her parents, Andrew and Addie (Gibson) Elm; her husband, Harvey Moses in 1995; daughter, Karen Sue Moses in 1992 and granddaughter, Carrie Moses in 2003.

Minerva is survived by her two daughters, Kathleen (Keith) Thomas and Nanette Moses both of the Onondaga Nation; five sons, Harvey Sr. (Peggy) Moses of Nedrow, New York, Allen (Deborah) Moses of Adams Center, New York, Gary and Karl Moses both of the Onondaga Nation and Randy (Rosalie) Moses of Syracuse, New York; sister, Caroline Wilbur of Syracuse, New York; 20 grandchildren; 25 great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.
