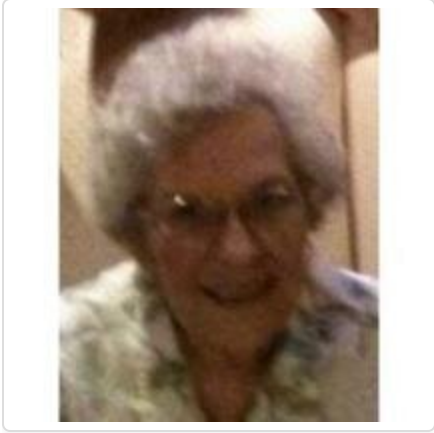




Nancy S. March (Sherman)

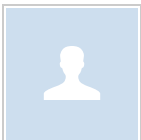
